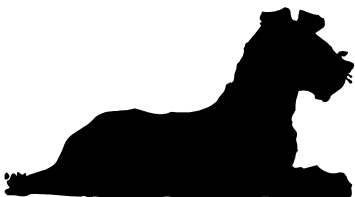


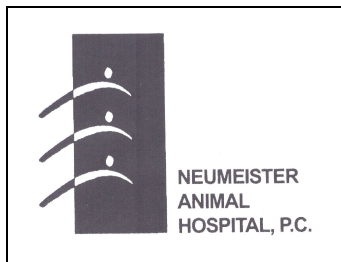
- \*Annual physical exam including: vaccination boosters, stool check & heartworm/lyme test.
- \*Heartworm, flea & tick preventatives.
- \*Geriatric wellness screenings: CBC, CMP, thyroid profile, urinalysis, radiographs & ECG.
- \*Diet appropriate for senior animals.
- \*Regular home dental care.
- \*Professional dental care as needed.



- \*Annual physical exam including: vaccination boosters, stool check & heartworm/lyme test.
- \*Heartworm, flea & tick preventative.
- \*Regular exercise to promote good body conditioning.
- \*Good quality maintenance diet to help avoid health risks.
- \*Regular home dental care.
- \*Professional dental care as needed.

### Mature Adult

*2-8 years for small-breed dogs  
2-7 years for large-breed dogs*



### Young Adult

*6-12 months for small-breed dogs  
12-18 months for large-breed dogs*



- \*Spay or neuter
- \*Annual physical including: vaccination booster, stool check & heartworm/lyme test.
- \*Dental exam, permanent teeth should be in.
- \*Consider oral health vaccination to help slow infection that leads to tooth loss and health concerns. \*\* Highly recommended for small-breeds\*

- \*Start series of DHPPC vaccinations to be boosted every 3-4 weeks until 16 weeks of age.
- \*Rabies vaccination at 12 weeks of age.
- \*Start series of any other optional vaccinations. (bordetella, lyme, and leptospirosis)
- \*Stool check & deworming for intestinal parasites.
- \*High quality growth diet for proper development.
- \*Start heartworm, flea & tick preventatives.
- \*Positive contact with other people, children & pets- this 2-3month time frame is critical for proper socialization.
- \*Introduce home dental care.

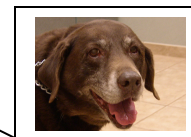
### PUPPY

*Over 6-8 years, depending on the breed*
