### Geriatric Adult 14-20 years

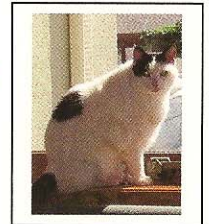


- \*Annual physical exam including: vaccination booster, stool check & heartworm test.
- \*Heartworm, flea & tick preventative.
- \*Regular exercise to promote good body conditioning.
- \*Good quality maintenance diet to help avoid health risks.
- \*Regular home dental care.
- \*Professional dental care as needed.



### Mature Adult 4-8 years

### Senior Adult 9-13 years



- \*Annual physical exams including: vaccination boosters & stool check.
- \*Senior wellness screenings: CBC, CMP, thyroid profile, urinalysis, radiographs & ECG.
- \*Heartworm, flea & tick preventatives for at risk cats.
- \*Diet appropriate for senior animals.
- \*Regular home dental care.
- \*Professional dental care as needed.



### Young Adult 6-12 months

- \*Spay or neuter
- \*If desired, declawing can be done at the time of spay or neuter.
- \*Dental exam, permanent teeth should be in.
- \*Switch to good quality adult maintenance diet.

- \*Discuss and test for Feline leukemia
- \*Start series of FVRCP vaccinations to be boosted every 3-4 weeks until 16 weeks of age.
- \*Start Leukemia vaccinations for at risk cats
- \*Rabies vaccination at 12 weeks of age.
- \*Stool check & deworming for intestinal parasites.
- \*High quality growth diet for proper development.
- \*Start heartworm, flea & tick preventatives for at risk cats.
- \*Introduce home dental care.

### Kitten 6-16 weeks of age
